

Art Therapy Residency

COUN 5002 Foundations Residency & COUN 5002 Group Residency

Course Description: Residency provides you with the opportunity to practice your art therapy and counseling skills with clinical supervision from your residency instructor. Throughout the residency, you will be expected to engage in practice sessions with your peers and apply feedback from your peers and instructors to improve your skills.

Residency is a 0 credit week long clinical training course and serves as a practical extension of the skills based courses COUN 5902 Foundational Skills, COUC 5402 Techniques & Practices, and COUN 6030 Group Counseling (AT).

Student cost for Residency is \$1,495.00 and includes small group supervision and skills training, and breakfast and lunch each day. Students are responsible for accommodations and travel expenses as well as any meals outside of Residency.

Residency will be held on one of the Antioch University Campuses, which includes Antioch Midwest in Yellow Springs Ohio, Antioch Seattle in Seattle, WA, Antioch New England in Keene, NH, and affiliate school Otterbein University in Westerville, OH. Applicants should consider the travel cost of each residency given their current living location and potential cost for accommodations and meals for at least 6 days. Students will receive detailed information about Residency location in the semester before Residency.
